Description of Study	The curriculum is centred upon consolidating the students' knowledge of English, with an emphasis on improving their skills in using the language and equipping them with the theoretical foundations that have extensive applications in the various areas connected with the English language and literature. In this respect, students are offered a range of practical courses (e.g., Text Interpretation, Composition, Translation, Grammar Exercises and Communication Techniques) and numerous theoretical and elective special courses in English, American and Irish literature, in which the approach is both synchronic and diachronic. There is also a wide variety of courses in literary theory and criticism, British, American or Irish culture and civilisation, lexicology, morphology and syntax, discourse theory, (formal) semantics, generative and transformational grammar.
