Profile of the Degree Programme	Studies in Philology
Target Group / Addressees	Romanian and foreign high school graduates that have special interest in studying Romanian language and foreign languages
Entrance Conditions	Average grade of: average grade obtained at the baccalaureate examination, the overall average grade per last year of high school studies, and the average grade per penultimate year of study in high school.
Further Education Possibilities	Master studies: <i>Romanian Literary Studies</i> and Romanian Language in Romance Context or other masteral programs in linguistic and humanistic studies
Description of Study	Having compulsory and optional disciplines, the program consists of three modules: a common core module (4 hours weekly), a Romanian Language and Literature module (9 hours weekly), and a foreign language and literature module (7 hours weekly). <i>The common core module</i> covers the following general training disciplines: Literary Theory, General Linguistics, Comparative Literature, Aesthetics, Poetics and Critics, Semiotics. <i>The Romanian language and literature module</i> covers specific training disciplines: Contemporary Romanian Language: Phonetics, Lexicology and Semantics, Morphology and Syntax; History of Romanian Language; Romanian Literature: Old, Pre-modern, Modern, Twentieth Century, Contemporary; Literary Folklore. There is also a package of optional courses: Romance Philology, Writers and Literary Trends, Sociolinguistics, Literary Canon, Pragmatics, The Romanian poetry of the twentieth century, Controversial Problems of Contemporary Romanian Language Morph-Syntax, The Romanian Prose of the twentieth century etc. <i>The foreign language and literature module</i> consists of disciplines that are proposed by other specific departments.
Purposes of the Programme	The wide broad objective of the program is to train

	<p>specialists in Romanian Language and Literature. This objective is provided by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the educational purpose: the syllabus is conceived in a such way that offers the knowledge and the necessary competences in order to integrate the future teachers in the secondary school system, where the Romanian Language and Literature is the main discipline; - the scientific purpose: growing interest in research, the best students are integrated into different research teams and projects; - the purpose of growing and creating new links, not only to similar Western specializations (devoted, thus, to national languages and literatures), but also to Departments of Romanistics from European universities, through agreements between universities and other kinds of partnerships and mutual projects.

Extra Peculiarities	The best students are encouraged to publish studies and reviews in cultural magazine “Echinox” or in other cultural and scientific journals with national range („Vatra”, „Steaua”, „Studii literare”, „Caietele Echinox”etc.).
Practical Training	Most of the students apply for and attend the pedagogical module, which ensures, in partnership with The Educational Inspectorate Cluj-Napoca, the activity of teaching practice in lower secondary and high schools in Cluj-Napoca
Final Examinations	Bachelor graduation thesis
Gained Abilities and Skills	At the end of the programme, the students have the necessary qualification for teaching and researching Romanian Language and Literature, and also communicative skills which make them capable of sustaining public relations activities.
Job Placement, Potential Field of Professional Activity	The graduates follow, mainly, the following professional activities: teacher of Romanian Language and Literature / foreign language, researcher; publishing editor, magazine editor, news producer / presenter, cultural manager, cultural mediator, documentarist etc. Sometimes, they get themselves a job in the public relations departments.
