Profile of the Degree Programme	Bachelor in Ukrainian Language and Literature
Target Group / Addressees	<p>The Ukrainian study programme addresses both the Ukrainian minority of Romania and those willing to learn one of the most beautiful Slavic languages (spoken by over 60 million people) – the Ukrainian language. For those who want to be initiated in the study of the Ukrainian language, culture and literature, the study of Ukrainian starts with the basics (beginner's level), – commencing with the Cyrillic alphabet. The Ukrainian language and literature study programme targets prospective students who desire to become knowledgeable in Ukrainian culture and literature and speak the Ukrainian language fluently.</p>

Description of Study	<p>While focusing on Ukrainian studies, courses cover a multidisciplinary area, from history, art, religion, and social studies, to Ukrainian language, linguistics, and literature. Students are encouraged to acquire a comprehensive knowledge of Ukrainian culture, viewed comparatively in the wider context of other Slavic history and culture. Topics range from ancient to modern society and art, in an attempt to create a complete outline of Ukrainian culture.</p> <p>Also, the curriculum is centred upon consolidating the students' knowledge of Ukrainian, with an emphasis on improving their skills in using the language and equipping them with the theoretical foundations that have extensive applications in the various areas connected with the Ukrainian language and literature. In this respect, students are offered a range of practical courses (e.g., Text Interpretation, Composition, Translation, Grammar Exercises and Communication Techniques) and numerous theoretical and elective special courses in Ukrainian language and literature, and Ukrainian dialectology, in</p>

	which the approach is both synchronic and diachronic. There is also a wide variety of courses in Ukrainian civilisation, phonetics, lexicology, morphology, syntax, dialectology and history of the Ukrainian language.
Purposes of the Programme	Developing the ability to speak, read, and write in the Ukrainian language (high intermediate level) and strengthening the students' competencies in language and literary studies and preparing them as future teachers of Ukrainian and / or translators; zone expertise; research; editing.
Specialization / Area of Expertise	Ukrainian language: syntax, morphology, lexicology; discourse analysis, conversational analysis; Ukrainian classical and modern literature, literary analysis, history Ukrainian culture and civilization dialectology and history of Ukrainian language.
