The students will be able to use knowledge for development, review and apposite audit of financial accounting statements of enterprises and business consulting for financial accounting and management quality - all in the context of (being) harmonization the legislation and practice of financial accounting and auditing at european and international regulations.</p> <p>The purpose of the programme is also to form graduates with the following abilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - knowledge and practical skills of using computer in specific tasks according to the specialization; - capacity of communication and mastery of a good economic language; - ability to translate theoretical knowledge into practical tools for addressing the reality and ability to make relevant connections between the accounting and other functions of an organization; - increasing the potential for understanding the business environment and the ability to think creatively; - gathering, analysis and interpretation of data and information in terms of quantity and quality from various sources, from real contexts and professional literature in the field, in order to formulate arguments, decisions and concrete steps; - use of various modes of written and oral, including at least one - two international languages (English, French); - use of technology for business purposes; - assuming the responsibility to develop a personal self design and specific business administration
