Target Group / Addressees	The envisaged target groups are formed by francophone applicants interested in developing a career in the area of Comparative European Politics, applicants who finished the B.A. courses, but also by any other categories, being available in intensive lecture series. The courses can be followed by any student of public universities within Europe.
Entrance Conditions	The Bachelor graduates willing to attend the courses are expected to write a 2 to 5 page research project (topics available on the internet) and to successfully cope with the questions and challenges of a career interview, that shall be carried interactively. It will consist in open discussions on topics from the guiding reader. The candidates ought to be able to bring arguments for their option for this MA programme and also to speak about their future perspectives and career expectations, in a professional manner. In case of equal averages, the following criteria shall be applied: 1. the grade of the Bachelor thesis; 2. the average grade of the faculty (only applicable should two candidates have the same grade at the Master entrance examination and at the Bachelor thesis).
Further Education Possibilities	The graduates of Comparative European Political Studies may continue through a co-tutorship PhD francophone programme of the two universities involved in the BA in history, philosophy or political science
Description of Study	The master programme Comparative European Political Studies is a co-tutorship programme established by the University Babes-Bolyai in Cluj (Romania) and Paris-Est Marne-la-Vallee (France). The aim of this programme is to prepare specialists of the dynamics of the European public sphere. Although the core of the disciplines are centred around political science and international relations, there is a transdisciplinary perspective that allows graduates to
