Description of Study	The master program in Transatlantic Studies trains students to acquire fundamental knowledge and expertise in a multidisciplinary area which combines cultural and political disciplines regarding the nature of the modernity and post-modernity in the geographical triangle of Europe, USA and Latin America. The main accents of the study fall on the perspectives opened in the field by intellectual history, political system and democratization, constitutions, the study of Americanization and the anti-American reaction, role of religion, post-colonialism and globalization, the Cold War, geopolitics, history of transatlantic relations, film studies. In these approaches discourse analysis and qualitative analysis are employed to provide students with methodological tools for an accurate perception of the cultural and political similarities and dissimilarities of the cultures and nations of the continents, as well as to acknowledge for the actual dissensions and tensions of the Atlantic partners.
