Entrance Conditions	When registering for entrance examination, the candidate will submit a research project on a topic at choice (10-12 pages). The project will be assessed by an expert committee and it will receive a grade <i>The final admission grade</i> of each candidate is calculated as the weighted mean of - graduation average grade (70% of the final mark) - project evaluation (30% of the final mark)
