Profile of the Degree Programme	Pastoral Counsellor degree programme
Target Group / Addressees	Course aimed at Hungarian speaking graduates coming from all accredited higher education institutions and willing to train as professionals in the field of pastoral counselling.
Entrance Conditions	The admission exam consists of an oral exam designed to test the students' knowledge in the field of the chosen domain based on the given literature and to give the student the possibility to present her/his research project. This counts for 50% of the total, while the graduation examination average grade represents the remaining 50%.
Further Education Possibilities	The master's program aims at providing students with the appropriate tools for further doctoral studies.
Description of Study	<i>Core disciplines:</i> Personality and Developmental Psychology, Social Psychology and Group Leading, Crisis Intervention, Logotherapy, Pastoral Counselling Skills, The Personality of the Pastoral Counsellor, Psychopathology, Biblical Theology, Dogmatics.
Purposes of the Programme	The program is focused on (1) counseling skills and (2) adjustment of these skills to the pastoral context.
Specialization / Area of Expertise	The study programme aims to form specialists in the field of pastoral counselling, skillfull in managing related activities in the study subject, able to grant pastoral care, counseling to people with life management and religious problems, to recognize more severe psychological problems and to refer people struggling with them to psychological counseling or psychotherapy.

Practical Training	Master students have the opportunity – depending on their interest and willingness – to be involved in research and/or practical activities.
Final Examinations	Research thesis
Gained Abilities and Skills	The master program offers skills and abilities necessary for any professional and responsible pastoral counselor.
