Target Group / Addressees	Course aimed at Hungarian speaking graduates coming from all accredited higher education institutions and willing to train as professionals in the field of theology, culture and society.
Entrance Conditions	The admission exam consists of an oral exam designed to test the students' knowledge in the field of the chosen domain based on the given literature and to give the student the possibility to present her/his research project. This counts for 50% of the total, while the graduation examination average grade represents the remaining 50%.
Further Education Possibilities	The master's program aims at providing students with the appropriate tools for further doctoral studies.
Description of Study	<i>Core disciplines:</i> Dogmatics, Judeo-Christian Values, Biblical Theology, Comparative History of Religions, Ecumenic Theology, The Social Effects of the Roman Catholic Status.
