Description of Study	<p>The master's programme in Professional Ethics offers courses on major fields of applied and professional ethics (medicine, public policies, public and private organizations, research, and policing) as well as in related disciplines, such as: organisational psychology, human resources in public institutions, communication. Purposes of the Programme	The master degree aims at deepening the study of ethics, with a special focus on applied ethics in contemporary society.
Specialization / Area of Expertise	The programme is designed to offer the students capacities to recognize and solve ethical issues in various fields of activity.
Extra Peculiarities	In addition to the Babeş-Bolyai University degree, the master's graduates are granted a degree of Paris XII University (on the condition of the inscription in the joint degree programme)
Practical Training	Students undergo a practical training/internship in three types of organisations (corporations, public institutions, and NGO's) during the entire fourth semester
