| Profile of the Degree Programme | The Clinical Psychology, Psychological Counseling and Psychotherapy Master Program is organized to offer advanced training in the clinical field, based on international standards of excellence. The program is focused on health promotion and on the diagnosis and treatment of psychological disorders in the case of children, adults and the elderly. Theoretical and supervised practical activities are organized in the evidence-based practice model, advocating for the integration of best research evidence with clinical expertise and patient characteristics. The program is coordinated by the Department of Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy at the Babes-Bolyai University. Training and supervision in counseling and psychotherapy is offered in collaboration with the Romanian Association of Cognitive and Behavioral Psychotherapies and graduates are eligible for Romanian Board of Psychologists certification in Cognitive Behavioral Psychotherapy and Counseling. |

| Profile of the Degree Programme | Clinical psychology, psychological counseling, and psychotherapy degree program |
| Target Group / Addressees | Graduates with bachelor degree in psychology, social and human sciences and medicine. |
| Entrance Conditions | The admission exam consists of an oral exam designed to test the students' knowledge in the field of the chosen domain based on the given literature. This counts for 80% of the total, while the graduation examination average grade represents the remaining 20%. |
| Further Education Possibilities | The master's program aims at providing students with the appropriate tools for further doctoral studies. |
| Description of Study | The master's program corresponds to the "scientist-practitioner" and "evidence-based" paradigm providing a set of skills for both work performance and rapid integration into the labor market of graduates, and for advanced research. |
| Purposes of the Programme | The program is focused on (1) health promotion and (2) diagnosis and treatment of disorders involved in the etiopathogenesis of psychological factors (for children, adults and third age). |
| Specialization / Area of Expertise | The master's program offers specialization in: (1) clinical psychology (2) counseling and (3) psychotherapy. |
| Extra Peculiarities | The courses and the seminars of the master's program are supported by recognized professors from the country or abroad. |
| Practical Training | Specialty practice can be accomplished in the department's own units (for example PsyTech) or in establishments approved by the department, with appropriate supervision. Master students have the opportunity – depending on their interest and willingness – to be involved in research and/or practical activities (some of them are paid). The students are also supported to participate in traineeships abroad. They may also participate (at some levels) at "Meeting of the Minds Conference Series", being a formative framework of scientific and professional elite. |
