Entrance Conditions	The admission exam consists of an oral exam designed to test the students' knowledge in the field of the chosen domain based on the given literature. The oral exam counts for 60% of the total, while the graduation examination average grade represents the remaining 40%.
Further Education Possibilities	The Master's program aims at providing students with the appropriate tools for further doctoral studies.
Description of Study	The Master's program corresponds to the "scientist-practitioner" paradigm. It proposes courses on: <i>Curriculum management; Metacognitive and self regulated learning; Curriculum at school decision; Theory and Practice of Pedagogical Research; Transferables Competences; Intercultural education, Media education, Scientific and Technological Education; Education for environment and sustainable development; Mathematical culture; Education for law, citizen rights, environment rights and children rights.
