DECISION

on granting free access to the Alexandru Borza Botanical Garden for refugees, asylum seekers and persons granted any protection in Romania as a result of the armed conflict in Ukraine

In view of the situation generated by the Russian military aggression in Ukraine, which has generated large-scale emigration of Ukrainians from the country and the consequent need to provide adequate conditions for foreign citizens or stateless persons in difficult living conditions coming from areas of armed conflict in Ukraine, as well as the provisions of the CJSU Cluj Decision no. 92/04.03.2022,

The Administrative Council of Babeş-Bolyai University of Cluj-Napoca, reunited in the meeting of 14 March 2022,

DECIDES:

Art. 1. Free access to the Alexandru Borza Botanical Garden is granted to refugees, asylum seekers or people who have been granted any protection in Romania as a result of the armed conflict in Ukraine, following calls from the signing parties of the Cooperation protocol on the aggregation of Cluj civic initiatives meant to counteract the impact of the armed conflict in Ukraine with the support of the public authorities, approved by the CJSU Cluj Decision no. 92/04.03.2022.

Art. 2. The provisions of Art. 1 also apply to refugees to whom the University has provided accommodation in its residence halls.
