Guidelines

Concerning the requirements applicable to Ukrainian pre-university graduates in the 2021-2022 school year, applying for undergraduate studies in higher education institutions in Romania

Given the political-military situation caused by the military aggression of the Russian Federation against Ukraine, please consider the following for the admission of Ukrainian citizens, including Romanians residing in Ukraine, to undergraduate studies in the 2022-2023 academic year:

- Romanians residing in the Odessa region of Ukraine are exempted from the requirement to submit a Statutory declaration confirming their Romanian cultural identity, certified by the Romanian authorities. Candidates will submit only a Declaration filled in by them. The legally certified statement will be submitted upon arrival in Romania, by the end of the first semester of the 2022-2023 academic year, and can be certified in Romania by the Department for Romanians Abroad, a dedicated agency within the Romanian Government.
- In order to apply for admission to undergraduate studies in higher education institutions in Romania, candidates who graduated from pre-university education in Ukraine in the 2021-2022 school year may submit a Certificate/Attestation of completion of preuniversity education or a Certificate issued by the school where they were enrolled, confirming the completion of pre-university education in the 2021-2022 school year. Please be informed that the Ukrainian authorities have cancelled the state examinations for completion of pre-university studies in the 2021-2022 school year.
- The authenticity of the documents confirming the completion of pre-university studies in Ukraine can be verified by consulting the official documents records,
