

**ADDENDUM 4**  
**RULES OF SOCIAL CONDUCT FOR THE PREVENTION OF THE SPREAD OF SARS-  
COV-2 (coronavirus) INFECTION IN STUDENT RESIDENCE HALLS AT BABEŞ-  
BOLYAI UNIVERSITY**

Each tenant has the obligation to conduct themselves in such a manner as to not expose any other person to the risk of infection with the SARS-COV-2 coronavirus. The tenants have the obligation to notify the administration of the residence halls and/or the Administration Committee of the residence hall about any condition posing a risk to themselves or other tenants of getting infected with the SARS-COV-2 coronavirus. The tenants have the obligation to comply with the rules of access to the residence hall, the sanitary and epidemiological requirements, in particular the following:

- wear the protective mask correctly (covering both the mouth and the nose) in all the shared areas of the residence halls (lobby, stairway, shared bathroom, shared kitchen, elevator, laundry, residence hall administration office, etc.)
- disinfect their hands whenever they enter the residence hall
- limit any direct contact with others
- keep a safe distance of at least 1m from others
- wash their hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially when returning to the residence hall
- maintain a hygienic and clean room, bathroom, and kitchen space
- sanitise as often as possible the frequently touched surfaces in the room, bathroom, kitchen, with disinfectant products based on alcohol or chlorine, approved by the Ministry of Health
- avoid touching surfaces frequently touched by others (railings, door handles, elevator knobs, switches, handles, etc.)
- ventilate the residence hall room several times a day
- not to use the personal belongings of roommates (cutlery, towel, crockery, tablet, laptop, phone, writing tools, etc.)
- avoid sharing food and/or beverages
- not to make cooked food in the room
- not to use another heating source in addition to the existing facilities
- dispose of the face mask only in the waste bin provided at the entrance to the residence hall and, if the protective face mask is removed in the room, the mask must be packed in an enclosed plastic bag before it is discarded in the waste bin
- empty the room waste bin in the provided rubbish bins, at least once a day.
- avoid travelling. If the tenant has travelled to an area at risk of infection with the SARS-COV-2 virus, they have the obligation to self-isolate at home for at least 14 days. Self-isolation in residence halls can be done only with the approval of the Babeş-Bolyai University executive leadership.
- remain in their room if they have flu or cold symptoms and to immediately notify the family doctor/ student clinic practitioner, DSP (Department of Public Health), and the residence hall administrator.

- avoid the use of banknotes and coins for the payment of their accommodation fees and to pay by card or by bank transfer
- follow the markings on the floor and notices within the residence hall both when getting in and out
- accept the checks of body temperature at the entrance to the residence hall
- access to confined spaces will be limited to maximum two people at a time
- not to enter the lift if there is already a person in it
- not to receive visitors in their residence hall room, even if they are accommodated in the same residence hall
- during their stay in the residence hall, they have the obligation to fill out a statutory declaration provided by UBB
- an entrance will be provided for access to the residence hall conditional on the presentation of a student ID card (valid at the time of entry). The access of students, employees, doctoral students, or any other person who justifies their presence in the accommodation spaces will be allowed following the epidemiological triage (checking body temperature) using the medical equipment provided by the university and after disinfecting their hands using the wall mounted sanitiser dispensers provided at the entrance to the building
- persons who do not provide proof of accommodation in the hall of residence, unless justified, will be denied entry
- all shared spaces will be avoided as much as possible and the study activities will be pursued in the tenant's personal room
- in the event of a suspect or confirmed case with SARS-CoV-2, the isolation protocol adopted at university level will be implemented and the Department of Public Health Cluj-Napoca, phone 0264-433-645, will be informed and the emergency service will be called at 112. Immediate isolation of the accommodated person from their roommates is required and they will be supervised until they are picked up and leave the hall accompanied by the ambulance staff.
- a person who has been in direct contact or infected with SARS-CoV- 2 will be allowed to return to the accommodation only on the basis of a quarantine/isolation permit confirming that the person has completed the 14-day quarantine/isolation period.

### **Individual protection measures**

#### **Important messages:**

- **Wash your hands regularly!**
- **Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue!**
- **Use a disposable tissue, then discard in the bin!**
- **Greet others without shaking hands!**
- **Do not hug!**
- **Keep physical distance, avoid crowds!**
- **Wear a mask when inside the UBB residence halls!**
