

**ORGANISING AND CONDUCTING RE-EXAMINATIONS AT UBB
IN THE CONTEXT OF SUSPENDING FACE-TO-FACE TEACHING ACTIVITIES**

If a state of emergency, alert or necessity requires the suspension of face-to-face teaching activities and conducting them online, the *Regulation on the professional activity of students at Babeş-Bolyai University under the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)* will be supplemented with the following provisions, which will be in effect until the situation allows the resumption of face-to-face teaching activities:

1. Examination and re-examination sessions will be conducted according to the calendar initially put forward by the faculties and approved by the Rector's Office in the structure of the current academic year.
2. The examinations will be conducted online, on a platform selected by the tenured course holder from among multiple platforms recommended and made available by the faculty or university. Oral exams conducted online can be recorded upon teacher's request, with the approval of the students assessed and in full conformity with the regulations on personal data protection. Students shall be informed of any changes to the method of evaluation or the grading system outlined by the syllabus in a timely manner, prior to the examination or project submission deadlines.
3. For specialisations where practical training cannot be carried out in a state of emergency, alert or necessity, practical training will be rescheduled, without payment, for the following academic year. Students in this situation will be treated as having completed all credits successfully, cumulating 30-x credits/semester, where x is the number of credits allocated to the practical training. Therefore, the average scores of these students will be calculated excluding the grade and the credits allocated to the practical training.
4. For the final years, if the practical training or practicum/laboratory work/projects in the syllabus cannot be carried out under conditions of emergency, alert or necessity (and cannot be substituted by computer modelling, design, data processing), upon the proposal of the course holder and with the approval of the Faculty Council, such assignments will be supplanted by other feasible online assignments that can yield similar skills.
5. Courses that require practical training, laboratory work or projects that cannot be replaced by computer modelling, design, data processing, will be assessed only in terms of coursework and/or seminars, with practical/laboratory work to be recuperated in the following academic year.
6. The teaching staff at the Faculty of Physical Education and Sport will create videos on training and physical exercises, which will be made available to students at all UBB faculties. In order to pass Physical Education and obtain the credit points allocated, students will practice these workouts at home.
7. The annual learning agreement is filled out in AcademicInfo, printed, signed by hand, scanned and uploaded by the student until the beginning of the academic year on the same platform.
8. All other provisions of the *Regulation on the professional activity of students at Babeş-Bolyai University under the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)* remain in effect with the adoption of this Addendum.
9. When the context at the national level changes so that it allows the resumption of face-to-face teaching activities, the provisions of this addendum will no longer be valid, and the *Regulation on the professional activity of students at Babeş-Bolyai University under the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS)* will fully apply.
