



Addendum 1 to the ACR No. 14115 / 28th September 2020

CONDITIONS FOR THE SUSPENSION OF DIDACTIC ACTIVITIES REQUIRING PHYSICAL PRESENCE

Considering that educational activities at Babeş-Bolyai University take place in different locations around Cluj-Napoca/extensions from other towns, should there be a case/several cases of COVID-19 spread, the situation will be analysed by DPH (Department for Public Health) together with the university governing bodies.

According to the joint Order of the Ministries of Education and Research and, respectively, of Health, No. 5487/1494/2020, didactic activities requiring students' physical presence (onsite) are suspended in the following situations:

I. Spread of COVID-19 among students:

I.1. Upon the emergence of a case in a study group within a location – all onsite didactic activities are suspended for 14 days; moving into the online, for the following categories: the respective group; study groups with whom the respective infected group had joint didactic activities; teaching staff who organised activities with the students from the respective group; all student groups with whom the respective teaching staff interacted.

I.2. Upon the emergence of three simultaneous cases within the same location – all onsite didactic activities are suspended for 14 days, moving into the online, for the entire location.

I.3. Upon the emergence of three simultaneous cases in at least two different locations - all onsite didactic activities are suspended for 14 days, moving into the online, for each location separately. Also, doctoral studies will be suspended.

II. COVID-19 spread among teaching staff:

II.1. Didactic activities with one study group – all onsite didactic activities are suspended for 14 days, moving into the online, for each member of the teaching staff and the respective group. Teaching staff who came into contact with their peer who tested positive will carry their didactic activities online.

II.2. Didactic activities will several study groups – all onsite didactic activities are suspended for 14 days, moving into the online, for the respective member of the teaching staff and the respective groups. Teaching staff who came into contact with their peer who tested positive will carry their didactic activities online. If the number of teaching staff the infected person came into contact with is high, the entire location or, should the case require it, the university will suspend its onsite didactic activities, moving into the online.

Any alteration of this structure for the development of didactic activities, as a consequence of the evolution of the pandemic and/or issue of new legal regulations, will be submitted for approval by the university senate.
