



Addendum 7 to the ACR No. 14115 / 28<sup>th</sup> September 2020

## Babeş-Bolyai University COVID-19 Protocol for the Dormitories

*In compliance with the provisions of Order No. 5487/1494/2020 for the approval of measures of organising activities within education units/institutions under conditions of epidemiological safety for preventing the spread of SARS-CoV-2, the following measures are declared mandatory:*

<b>Essential measures for preventing/limiting the spread of SARS-CoV-2</b>	1. Rigorous hand hygiene
	2. Firm cleaning and disinfection measures in student dormitories
	3. Both inhabitants and the entire staff must wear protection masks while in the common areas in students dormitories
	4. Contact among students and students and personnel will take place online, or face to face wearing a mask and keeping a 1,5 m distance
	5. Avoid changing students' accommodation place
	6. Permanently keeping with the 1,5 m distance in the common areas of student dorms and at least 1 m distance between roommates
	7. Permanently informing inhabitants on the protection measures to be taken against the spread of SARS-CoV-2 (addendum 2 to the lease contract, posters, notices)
	8. Isolating the tenants presenting COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, difficulty in breathing, loss of taste and smell) and of their roommates
<b>Specific measures of protection in student dormitories</b>	1. Establishing traffic trails, marked by a visible tape, inside student dorms, dorm entries and exits
	2. Access of any outsider in student dorms will be forbidden, except outstanding cases (with the approval of the head of the Social Service and/or the dorm administrator)
	3. Access into the dorm will be made through one entry based on the student card (updated). The access of students, employees, Ph.D. students or other people justifying their presence in the accommodation areas will only be granted after an epidemiological triage according to the triage protocol and after disinfection of hands with the disinfectant made available at the entry into student dorms.
	4. Insuring very frequent ventilation of common areas.
	5. Insuring the daily cleaning and disinfection of common areas according to the operational procedure regarding the organisation and cleaning for the prevention of the spread of SARS-CoV-2 in the accommodation areas – student dormitories.
	6. Placing special trash bins for the disposal of used protection masks, upon entry into student dorms.
Beds and desks in the student dorm rooms will be placed in order that the students do not face each other and physical distance among roommates is of min. 1m.	



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	7. Rooms will be occupied, as much as possible, by students from the same specialisation/level of study in order to limit contact with students from other study groups.
	8. Posting notices/posters announcing the limit of access of more than two people in the dorms' common areas.
	9. Wandering around the dormitories will be limited, and crowds will be avoided.
	10. Placing disinfectant dispensers at the entry into student dorms.
	11. Imperative demand that norms of hygiene be respected within the common areas and in the living spaces of the student dorms – visible posters on each floor.
	12. Using only the cleaning products and active anti-virus substances approved by the Ministry of Health.
	13. Permanently informing the staff on the protection measures taken against the spread of SARS-CoV-2.
	14. Elaborating specific operational procedures regarding the cleaning/disinfection activity and of the quarantine/isolation procedure within student dormitories.
	15. Daily check-up by the dorm administration of the daily cleaning and disinfection process of area most frequently touched.
	16. Information will be posted regarding the correct hygiene, on each floor of each student dorm.
	17. People access and flow will be managed at the entry into student dorms, by doormen, so that the 1,5 m physical distance be maintained and triage protocol be complied with.
	18. Instruction of personnel handling security/surveillance of student dormitories regarding the specific operational regulations of student dorms regarding the prevention/limitation of the spread of SARS-CoV-2.
	19. Weekly evaluation of the necessary and availability of cleaning, disinfection products and of personal protection equipment that is proper for the former's use.
	20. Identifying and reporting the health status of students accommodated in the student dorm by the hired staff who carry on their activity within the student dorm, and reporting the people who present respiratory symptoms.
<b>Individual protection measures in student dorms</b>	1. All students and hired staff must disinfect their hands upon entering the student dorm and any time it is necessary.
	2. All students and hired staff must wear the protection mask appropriately so long as they are in the dorm common areas and during an activity within the student dorms.
	3. Contact with frequently touched surfaces (doors, door knobs, light switches, lift buttons etc.) will be avoided, and disinfection of the hands is required after doing so.
	4. The exchange of personal objects or their common use are forbidden.
	5. The common use of food or beverage is forbidden.
	6. Living rooms will be ventilated by the tenants for a min. of 30 minutes in the morning and as frequently as possible during the day.

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	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Students will be informed on the provisions and rules of complying with the isolation protocol.</li><li>Common areas shall be avoided as much as possible, and study activities will take place in one's own room (it is forbidden to prepare hot food in the room).</li><li>Students must maintain the cleanliness, disinfect and ventilate their rooms on a regular basis.</li><li>Students accommodated in student dorms must notice the dorm administrator on their absence from the dorm overnight.</li></ol>
<b>Specific protection measures in the student dorms in case of quarantine/isolation</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>In the case of a suspect or confirmed case of SARS-CoV-2, the isolation protocol adopted at a university level will be applied.</li><li>Immediate isolation of the student presenting SARS-CoV-2 symptoms and of their roommate will only be done in strict compliance with the individual protection measures.</li><li>The student under quarantine/isolation in the dorm will not be transported to the general physician/doctor at the student clinic*, and/or the emergency room or the hospital, unless the symptoms are severe, in which case they will call the emergency no. 112; the person helping the isolated student must avoid contact with the latter, wear a mask and wash their hands for a min. of 20 seconds before and after the interaction.</li><li>The room will be cleaned with the special disinfectant, after the student will have left, in order to reduce the risk of transmitting the infection to other people.</li><li>Employees working within student dorms and presenting the symptoms of a potential infectious disease, will isolate themselves at home, contact the general physician/doctor at the student clinic* and inform the dorm administrator as soon as possible.</li></ol>
<b>Individual protection measures</b> <i>Important notices</i>	<p>Wash your hands frequently!</p> <p>Cough or sneeze in your elbow or in a napkin!</p> <p>Use the single-use napkin and throw it away!</p> <p>Greet others without shaking hands!</p> <p>Don't hug each other!</p> <p>Maintain physical distance, avoid crowds!</p> <p>Wear a mask when you are inside any building or outside in crowded areas!</p> <p>Wear the mask appropriately – completely cover the nose and mouth!</p>
