RESOLUTION

regarding measures for travels abroad and within the country during the state of alert

Considering the end of lockdown and the beginning of the state of alert at a national level, stated by the Resolution of the Committee for Emergency no. 24/20202, the GEO no. 70/2020 regarding certain measures to be implemented beginning with 15th May 2020, within the context of the pandemic due to the spread of SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus, in order to prolong certain terms, alter and add to the Law no. 227/2015 of the Fiscal Code, of the National Education Law no. 1/2011, as well as other pieces of legislation,

Based on their electronic vote from 14th May 2020, the UBB Administration Council

DECIDED UPON THE FOLLOWING

1. All UBB students' and employees' travels abroad for professional reasons are cancelled during 15th May and 14th June 2020, with the possibility of prolongation depending on the progress of the SARS-CoV-2 spread.
2. UBB students' and employees' travels within the country, for professional purposes, which the good functioning of the university depends upon, will be achieved exclusively with the rector's prior approval.
