RESOLUTION
regarding the extension of terms in scientific research activities
during the state of emergency and the COVID-19 pandemic

Considering the state of emergency in Romania, and the global events caused by the COVID-19 pandemic,

The UBB Administration Council assembled on 6th April 2020,

DECIDES UPON THE FOLLOWING:

1. The 2019-2020 grants for Young Researchers (GTC) are signed upon 1st April 2020 with a period of implementation of 12 months. Exception: cases where the grant director considers that the implementation of a GTC grant starting 1st April 2020 is not possible; in those cases, the respective grant will be signed only after the lift of the state of emergency. The 12-month term of implementation will, depending on each case, begin upon signature. The grant director makes the decision regarding the date of signature, and they have to immediately notify the Centre for the Management of Scientific Research (CMCS) regarding their decision.
2. In the case of ongoing grants for supporting UBB employees' competitiveness/ ongoing grants of didactical professional development, the period for spending the respective figures is extended by 6 months from the time the state of emergency is lifted, but no later than 30th September 2020.
3. In the case of other categories of research projects (special fellowships etc.) that are being funded, upon request, the extension of their implementation in compliance with the legal provisions can be subject to analysis.
