

FACULTIES COVID-19 PROTOCOL

Rules to comply with during academic activity

Entry into building	Triage according to the triage protocol
	Upon each entry into BBU buildings, there will be hand disinfectants
	Everyone entering BBU buildings must disinfect their hands upon entry
	The mask must be appropriately worn by everyone inside the building, as well as outside if crowded
	At least 1 metre distance between 2 people, at all times (students and teachers, inside and outside)
	Declaring a room as isolation room where a student/teacher/administrative staff need medical attending (related to COVID-19 symptoms), during working hours
	Students must exclusively wait outside for the activity to begin
Posters will be published with clear protection instructions, upon entry into each room (specifying the wearing of the mask, >1m distance and hands disinfection)	

Entry into room	Disinfecting all surfaces within a seminar room/laboratory before the beginning of the activity
	Students will enter room only at the start of the class (will not wait inside rooms)
	Disinfectants are present in each room
	Students will disinfect their hands upon entry into room

Didactic activity	Declaring and self-assessing any COVID-19 symptoms by students and teachers during activities – applying triage protocol
	Teaching and administrative staff must not encourage the open promotion and dissemination of fake news on COVID-19, within the university
	Constantly insuring a 1sqm distance between people during the didactic activity

Breaks Shifted breaks so that the maximum number of students on hallways be less than the sqm surface of hallways

Disinfection of faculty bathrooms before the start of activity

Disinfection of plane surfaces in common areas

Mandatory disinfection of surfaces and devices after students' use

Mandatory ventilation of rooms during and between activities (min. 30 min.)

Food products will be consumed in solitude, with caution to comply with norms of hygiene
