

**COVID-19 PROTOCOL FOR STUDENT CANTEENS AND CAFETERIAS**

<b>triage upon entry</b>	Upon entering a particular area outside the building of a food unit, an observational triage of students will be performed – according to the triage protocol
<b>mask</b>	Entry will be allowed only if appropriately wearing the mask Students will be allowed to take mask off only when sitting at the table
<b>circuits</b>	Students will walk inside the canteen/cafeteria only by following the clearly signalled one-way circuits, in order to minimise contact among students (e.g., to and from restrooms)
<b>meals</b>	The transfer of any object from one table to another is forbidden (e.g., salt and pepper shakers, oil recipients etc.) All objects on tables will be disinfected after the students' exit A minimum distance of 1m must be kept between those sitting at neighbouring tables, and between tables
<b>servicing</b>	Preferably, all types of serving will be paid by card Staff will permanently wear a mask when serving Disinfection of hands before serving each table is mandatory Students will be informed on rules of hygiene, disinfection and physical distancing, as well as on the necessity to limit time of serving a meal (where the case); information will be provided via posters and signs in clearly visible places
<b>disinfectants</b>	Cleaning and disinfection with approved disinfectants of all spaces/areas accessed by clients, as well as of utensils used while eating Upon entering the particular area outside the building of a food unit and in restrooms there will be devices with approved disinfectants so students may disinfect their hands Students will be informed on the use of disinfectants via posters near such devices An additional protection of food products in open showcases or buffets in serving and consumption areas will be set, by limiting clients' access to products and foods, which will be served by staff assisting with the service of products from showcases and buffets.
