

BRIEFING

Considering the current pandemic context, as well as applicable measures mentioned in the joint Order of the Ministry of Education and that of Health No. 5196/1756/2021 of 3rd September 2021 for the approval of measures of organising the activity within education units/institutions, under epidemiologically safe conditions for the prevention of SARS-CoV-2, and according to the methodology of COVID-19 supervision (updated 18.09.2020), we ask that you comply with the procedure of addressing the students' medical offices of the faculty where you are enrolled, as follows:

- Exams will be done upon prior appointment made by phone, according to the schedule listed and to the specified phone numbers.
- Appointments made by phone will only be scheduled during the working hours of the medical office of each faculty. WE ask that you comply with the schedule of each faculty!
- **Should you present COVID-19 symptoms**, such as fever, cough, muscle aches, throat aches, loss of taste or smell, altered general wellbeing, **do not leave the dorm room or your home**. Call the students' medical office or 112 (if outside of medical office working hours).
- When visiting the medical office, according to the appointment made by phone, you must wear a mask appropriately so that it covers nose and mouth; you must disinfect your soles upon entering the waiting room by stepping onto the disinfecting carpet, and you must disinfect your hands with alcohol-based disinfectant from the existing non-contact dispensers in the waiting room. **AFTER THAT, DO NOT TOUCH YOUR MASK, FACE OR NOSE!**
- You must comply with the entry and exit circuits, as indicated upon entering a building, so that you do not exit the same way you exit the medical office.
- In the waiting room, no more than two people are allowed. Please comply with the measures of social distancing of min. 2 metres. **YOU MUST NOT TAKE OFF MASK UNTIL EXITING THE BUILDING!**
- Upon entering the medical office, there will be a triage operation, based on measuring temperature.
- In case of emergencies (other than those specific to COVID-19, for which you will call 112 and not leave the dorm room or your home), we ask that you inform us beforehand. Major emergencies are answered to during 8.30-18.30, in the case of all students irrespective of their faculties' schedules.
