



Decision No. 117 of 23/09/2021
on the circumstances under which instructional activities involving in person
attendance of students will be suspended

Considering the Decision no. 11 214/20.09.2021 of the Babeș-Bolyai University Administrative Council on the circumstances under which instructional activities involving in person attendance of students will be suspended,

Having regard to the provisions of art. 7 of GEO no. 144/2020 as amended by art. I point 1 of GEO 99/2021 and of art. 3 paragraph 3 of the Joint Order no. 5196/2021 and no. 1756/2021 of the Minister of Education and the Minister of Health,

In consideration of the provisions of art. 6 para. 6 of the Joint Order no. 5196/2021 and no. 1756/2021 of the Minister of Education and the Minister of Health, which apply to the pre-university education system,

In light of the Curriculum Committee's and the Quality Assurance and University Development Committee's positive recommendations,

According to art. 39 let. f) of the Babeș-Bolyai University Charter,

the Babeș-Bolyai University Senate,
reunited in the extraordinary online meeting on 23 September 2021,
decides:

Art. 1. In the event of a positive case tested within a study group at a location, on-site teaching activities will be suspended for 14 days, and the teaching activities of that group will be moved online. If two or more study groups conduct their teaching activities in the same room, the teaching activities that require in person attendance will be suspended only for the study group in which the COVID-19 infection was confirmed, cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation will be ensured, and students from other groups will be able to continue with their activities as usual.

Art. 2. If students are tested at an authorised health care provider and the result is negative, in-person attendance for the suspended group can be resumed on the eighth day following the date of confirmation of the positive case.

Art. 3. Students will attend their teaching activities online until the test results come through. Students who are not tested may resume in person attendance 14 days after the in-person courses have been discontinued.

Art. 4. By exception from the provisions of art. 1, in the case of asymptomatic students who have been vaccinated against SARS-CoV-2 virus and have had at least 10 days since the completion of the entire vaccination scheme, as well as asymptomatic students who have tested positive for SARS-CoV-2 virus infection in the last 180 days but have had more than 14 days since the date of the positive test, the faculties, with the approval of the Administrative Council, faculties may decide to continue teaching activities in person.
