DECISION
on amending and supplementing the
Administrative Council Decision No. 5751/7.06.2021

Considering the pandemic caused by COVID-19,

At the recommendation of student leaders and in order to support students, residence halls will not be closed throughout the summer.

Taking into account the national pandemic prevention measures and the commitment to prevent COVID-19 outbreaks from developing on UBB campuses,

Taking into consideration HCA no. 5751/7.06.2021 on student accommodation in residence halls,

The Administrative Council of Babeş-Bolyai University, following the electronic vote cast on 18 June 2021,

DECIDES:

Art. 1 The following amendment to art. 1 of HCA no. 5751/7.06.2021 is hereby approved:

“Accommodation in student residence halls is approved for the period 12 July-15 September 2021, only within the limitations of availability, in terms of maximum health safety, and only for the following categories:

- a) individuals who have been vaccinated against the SARS-CoV-2 virus and 10 days have passed after the completion of the entire immunisation programme;
- b) individuals who present a negative RT-PCR test result that is less than 72 hours old;
- c) individuals who present a certified negative result of a fast antigen test that is no more than 24 hours old;
- d) individuals who range between the 15th and 90th day after being confirmed with SARS-CoV-2 infection.

The tests in paragraph b) will be repeated once every three days, while those in paragraph c) will be repeated on a daily basis.

The support staff in the residence halls must also be in one of the situations listed in paragraphs a)-d) of this article.


Students who will be required to participate in mandatory academic and research activities that require their physical presence in Cluj-Napoca but do not wish to do so under the criteria outlined in this article will be able to attend these activities online.”

Art. 2. The following supplementation to art. 3 of HCA no. 5751/7.06.2021 is hereby approved:

“The additional measures required are due to the vulnerability of this group of people and must provide greater protection to increase the safety of accommodation.”
